1. How Will You Use the Space?

Every yard is different, and the "best" turf depends on its primary purpose.

- **Play Area:** Is this for kids? You might want a softer, more cushioned blade for falls and sports.
- **Aesthetic Only:** Is this a front yard or a "look-but-don't-touch" space? We can focus on the most natural-looking, high-density blades.

2. The "Grain" and Viewing Point

Artificial turf has a "grain" (the direction the blades lean). For the most natural look, the grain should face your primary viewing area.

- **Think about:** Where do you spend most of your time? On the back deck looking out? Or looking at the yard from inside your kitchen window? Tell your estimator so we can plan the layout correctly.

3. The 15-Foot Rule

Our premium turf comes in professional **15-foot wide rolls**.

- **Consider your layout:** If your yard is wider than 15 feet, we will need to create a seam. We pride ourselves on "invisible" seams, but knowing your yard's dimensions helps us minimize waste and save you money on materials.

4. Access for Equipment

Installing 365 Turf requires moving several tons of base material (crushed stone).

- **Check your side yard:** Do we have at least 3 feet of clearance for a power wheelbarrow or equipment? If access is tight (e.g., through a garden gate), let us know so we can plan the labor accordingly.

5. Existing Irrigation & Drainage

Since we are also irrigation experts, we can integrate your systems.

- **Think about:** Do you have existing sprinklers? Do you want to keep garden beds watered while the lawn becomes maintenance-free? We can cap off old lawn heads and convert them to high-efficiency drip lines during the install.
